MEASURING BUSINESS REGULATIONS

Case Study: Cape Verde

Offered investors a five-year tax holiday, exemption from import duties, and unrestricted expatriation of profits in tourism

Revenues generated by foreign tourism **increased from \$23 million in 1999 to \$542 million in 2008**, and the sector now employs 21 percent of Cape Verde's workforce

Case Study: Lesotho

Lesotho developed industrial zones for the apparel industry and built rail links between them, offered incentives to foreign investors, and simplified the regulation of the sector.

Today, Lesotho's industry employs about **50,000 people in a country of just two million. 82% are women.**
