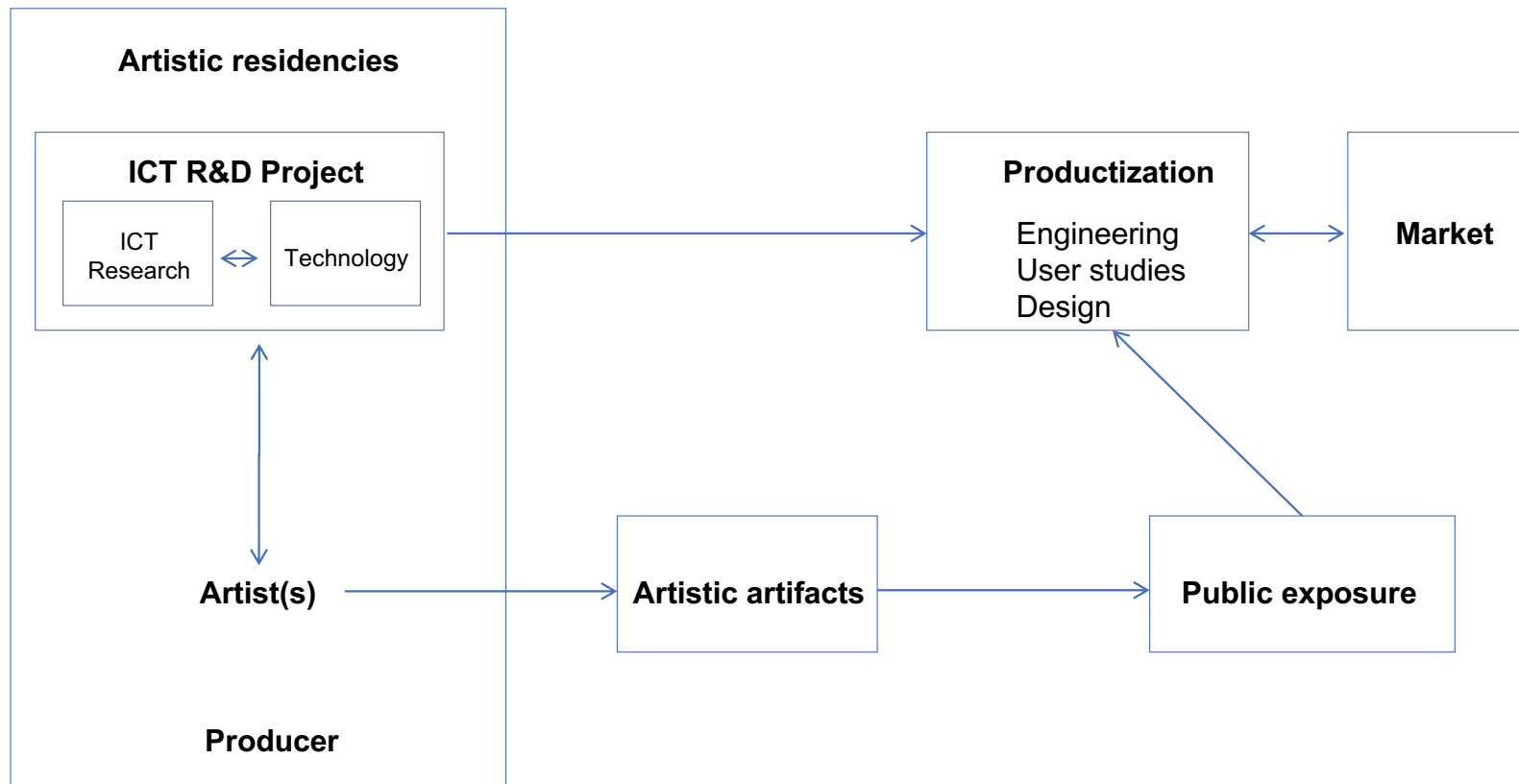
Purpose : bring tools and support to the STARTS community

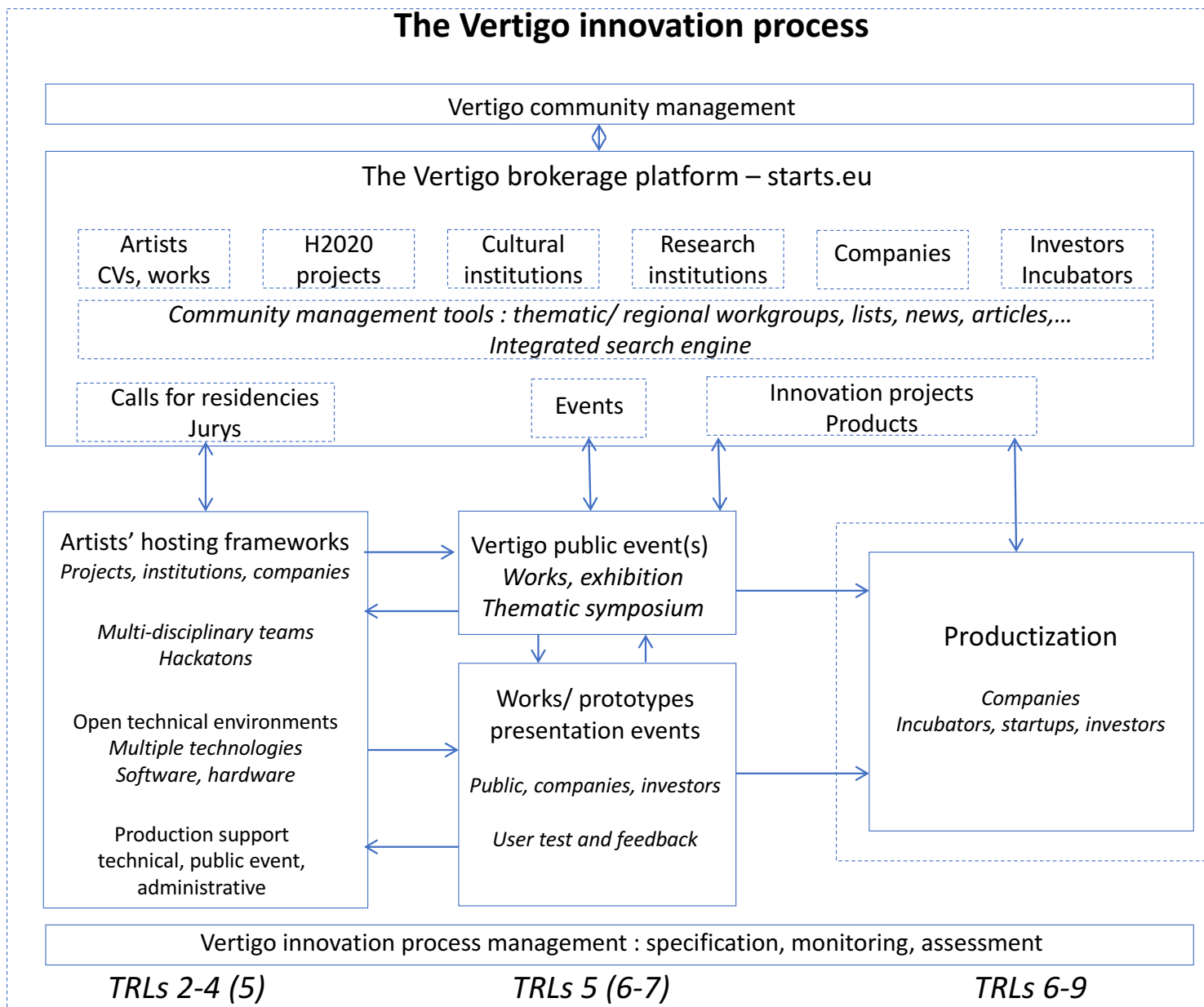
1. Organise and fund artistic residencies in ICT R&D projects throughout Europe

The VERTIGO innovation scheme



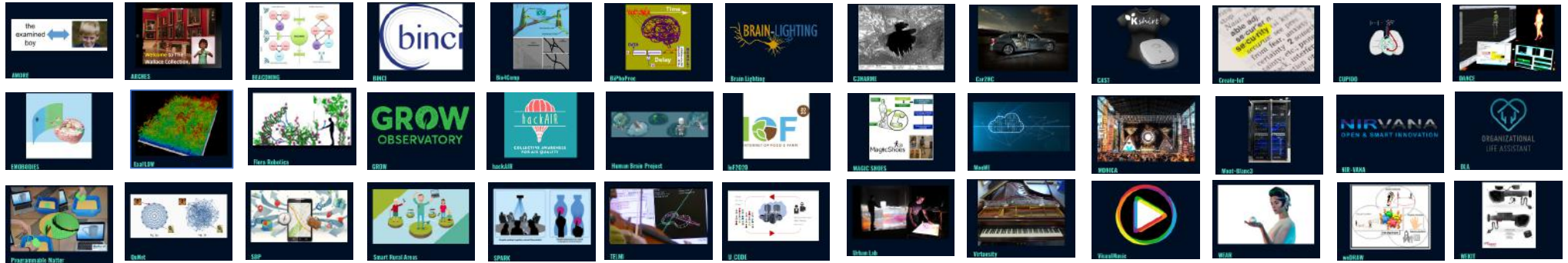




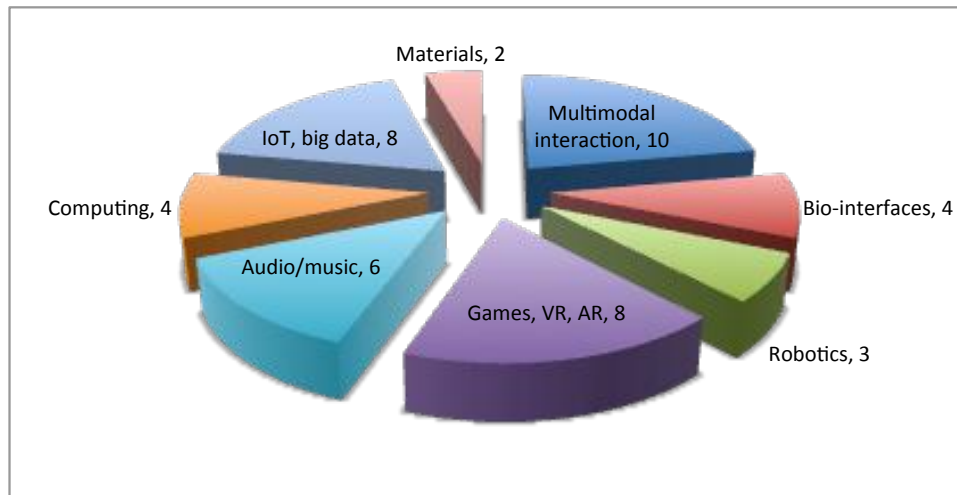
The VERTIGO STARTS residencies program

- **900 k€ budget – 45 residencies foreseen in 3 years**
- Applicants : R&D project/ artist(s) /producer triplet
- Artists paid directly by VERTIGO for designing an artwork using the R&D project technology
- 3 yearly calls : 2017 – 2018 – 2019
- First call 2017
 - Call for R&D ICT-Projects – March 14th -April 10th. **39 projects selected, all ICT fields**
 - Call for artists/ producers – April 21th- May 29th

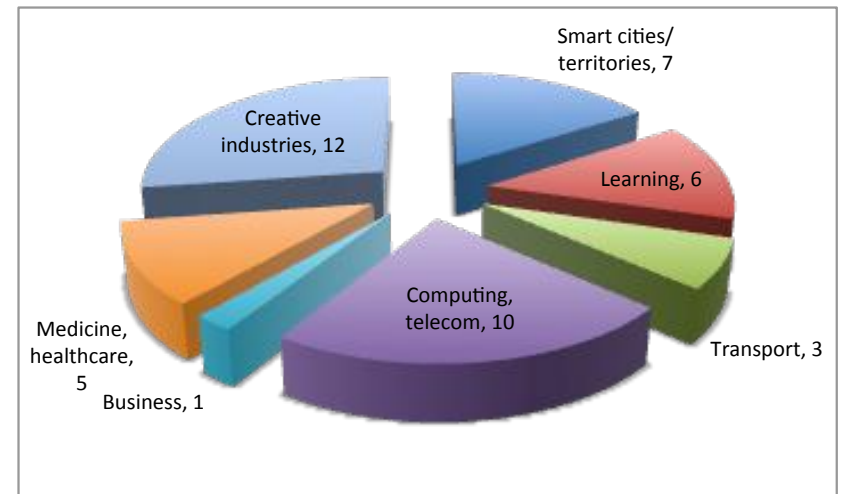
The 39 ICT projects selected for the 2017 call

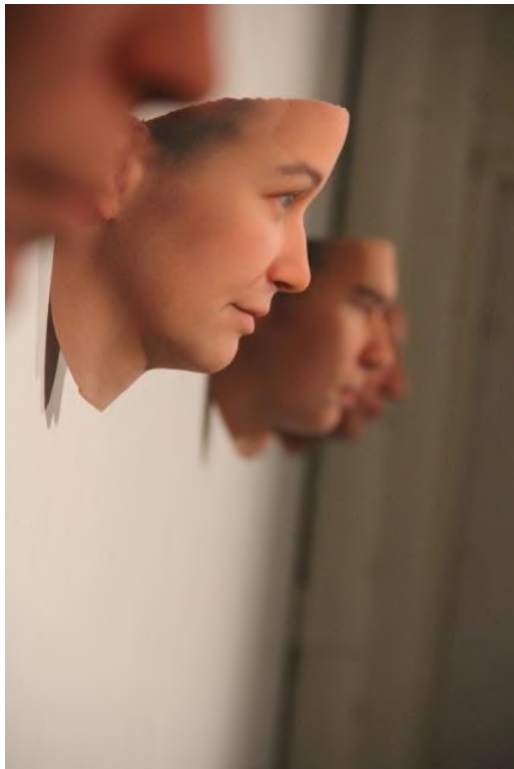
