1 St Martin's church

This neo-Gothic-style church is rightly called 'the pearl of the Meuse Valley'. The beautiful, colourful interior is one of a kind. Architect Jos Tonnaer promised the population in 1898 to build a gem of a village church and he kept that promise. The church door is always open. You can take a look at the beautiful interior without any obligation. This unique church certainly deserves an extended visit. An expert guide will be happy to show you around and tell you all about the construction of the church. The beautiful interior could be realised partly thanks to the generous donations of Willem Jozef, Baron Michiels of Kessenich. The tour of the church can be combined with a visit to 'De Berg' with the ruins of a medieval mote tower and a walk through the historical centre of Kessenich.



2 De Spaanjerd Marina

De Spaanjerd Marina brings the Mediterranean feeling to Kinrooi. Enjoy a wide view of bobbing boats or take the wheel in your own hands via one of the charter options. The Kinrooi Maasplassen offer something for everyone and will never get boring. Promise!



3 Kinrooise e-mobility

Would you like to explore the municipality in a sustainable way? With an e-car or e-scooter you can enjoy the most beautiful views in comfort and without any noise. Would you prefer guidance from an accompanying GPS or would you like to explore on your own? It is all possible. The e-cars can accommodate up to 4 people per car. Ideal for an activity with family, friends or relatives.



4 Kinrooie mills

Although the Netherlands is full of these monuments, you can also visit three beautiful windmills in Kinrooi. The Lemmensmolen, the Zorgvlietmolen and the Keijersmolen rise stately above the Kinrooi skyline. Today, you can get married in two of those mills. This makes Kinrooi not only a mill municipality, but also one of the nicest municipalities to get married in. More information? 5 Borgitter Castle

'Where in the bronze-green oak wood, the nightingale sings...', there lies Borgitter Castle. Unfortunately, very little remains of the former castle, just like the oak trees referred to. The present Maasland-style classicist building dates from the end of the 18th century. In the early 20th century, Dutchman Gerard Krekelberg wrote the lyrics for the Limburg anthem here in Kessenich, inspired by the oak trees surrounding this castle. The best of both Limburgs comes together in Kinrooi. You can see it, feel it and, above all, learn more about it at the new monument in honour of this national anthem.

THE BEST SPOTS for cyclists

Cycling through the Landscape Park

Koningssteen-Kollegreend (RivierPark Maasvallei) has recently become accessible to cyclists.

From junction 21, you can cycle straight through the nature reserve to eventually end up in the white town of Thorn. Enjoy the lovely views. Mind the grazing animals? They certainly need their rest.

Enchanting Kessenich

'The Pearl of the Maasland', 'Thorn's little brother',... Kessenich never ceases to surprise. Nice and compact with a historical touch at every corner of its little streets. A stone's throw from big sister Thorn and at the gateway to the Koningssteen-Kollegreend nature reserve, Kessenich has everything you need for a day out. The Bastion, so much more than an event site

Near junction 21 is the Bastion, one of the newest additions to the municipality of Kinrooi. This event site was artificially created by bringing sand from the Maasplassen. The Bastion is not only the home base for the famous Bastion Festival, but today also serves as a venue for all kinds of parties. From weddings, private parties to even a brilliant pop-up bar in summer. But above all, you have a beautiful view over the Kinrooise Maasplassen.

...from Woutershof

A forest paradise for young and old

Woutershof is not just a Hopper group accommodation where many young people enjoy a virtuous holiday every year. Located on the border of KempenBroek, Woutershof is also a gateway to this versatile nature reserve. Put on your walking shoes and get to know KempenBroek. A boundless hiking experience, promise!

While the children play in the woods, splash about in the play stream or play tag in the meadow, parents and grandparents enjoy a delicious picnic.

PRACTICAL

Woutershof is located at Grootbroekstraat in Molenbeersel. Ample parking is provided on site. Be sure to bring your walking shoes. You will need them.

...to The Goort

On a voyage of discovery with Tijn

De Goort is not only located in the middle of Kinrooi. It is also the home of Tijn the great oriole butterfly. Years of nature management have ensured that many animals found their way (back) to De Goort. Today, you will go on a walk there with Tijn the great oriole butterfly. This butterfly is the municipality's



adopted species and occasionally turns up in the area. During this walk, children aged 3 to 6 can learn about the habitat of this butterfly in a playful manner. So be sure to put on your walking shoes. Get mum, dad, grandma and grandpa out of the couch and head out!

PRACTICAL

This walk is about 2.5 km long and completely free of charge. You can easily leave your car in the car park at Doorslagstraat. The walk with Tijn is signposted along the green walking route.

...to Vijverbroek

Boundless enjoyment of nature

Vijverbroek is a marshland area on the border between Belgium and the Netherlands. Where the Meuse used to flow lushly, you now find the most beautiful marsh forests. It is best to put on your boots. The damp grasslands will soon get your feet wet. The Vijverbroek guarantees the ultimate nature experience. From alder thickets,

to willow thickets and the most beautiful plants. But look around once in a while, you might just see one of the stray cattle eager to accompany you on your trek.

You can go on several walks in Vijverbroek. Would you like more information about this? Then be sure to pop into Visit Kinrooi or drop at De Smakerij (Venlosesteenweg 403, 3640 Kinrooi).

CULTURAL Kinrooi

Kinrooi also plays in the first division when it comes to culture. As a fusion of five church villages, every corner of the municipality offers something for everyone. Apart from the three grinding mills, you will find other notable monuments in the municipality, such as Borgitter Castle, the ruins of the mottetower and St Martin's church, the Slichtenhof, etc.

But above all, Kinrooi is the vegetable garden of Flanders. More than 30 different varieties of fruit and vegetables are grown in Kinrooi. At the head of that garden is our queen of vegetables: asparagus. We celebrate this every two years with the asparagus festivals, but also with numerous annual activities and programmes. With, among other things, the asparagus route, dinner on the asparagus field, etc., we like to put our pride in the spotlight.



We list our cultural high-flyers for you below:

The Geistinger Vinkenbier

Taste these delicious regional beers in one of our many on-trade outlets, perhaps during the Vinkenbier walk. We will be happy to tell you more about it.

Asparagus municipality of Flanders

There is no arguing about taste? Perhaps not. But once you have tasted an asparagus from Kinrooi soil, you simply know that our asparagus is the tastiest in the world. That's not everything: be sure to visit again during asparagus season. You are always welcome at the annual asparagus activities, go on the asparagus bike ride or visit one of our local farmers. Maybe you'll even get to cut your asparagus yourself?



Mottetower

The Mottetower was built in the centre of Kessenich in the 12th century. It was built on an artificial hill and served as a defensive tower for the seigniori.

After three excavations, the foundations of the tower and the structures added later were uncovered and preserved. At the end of the 19th century, Baron Michiels van Kessenich erected a burial chapel for his family on the same hill.

In 2023, the site was fully restored. The "mountain" is freely accessible to the public.



St Martin's Church

At the foot of the same mountain is St Martin's Church. The back of the church tower contains remnants of a 12th-century Romanesque church. The marlstone tower dates from the 16th century. The present church was built against the existing tower in the late 19th century. The beautiful neo-Gothic interior rightfully earned this church the title of 'Pearl of the Maasland'. In the churchyard next to the church is the gravestone of Guido van Malsen (†1618), lord of Kessenich, and Joanna van Kessenich (†1636). Next to it is the grave cross of Hobrecht van Lind (†1678) and his relatives.

The Limburg Folk Song

"Where in the bronze-green oak ...", there lies Borgitter Castle; In the 16th and 17th centuries, the lords of Kessenich shifted their centre of power to Borgitter. Jan van Waes built the Borgitter water castle in the early 16th century. However, little remains of this castle today. The present Maasland-style classical building dates from the end of the 18th century. Behind the castle are the farms Breuksenshof and Halfeshof, the steward's house and a 17th-century water mill.

"... the nightingale sings ...", the Limburg anthem was also written there. In the early 20th century, Dutch writer Gerard Krekelberg wrote the lyrics here, which were later set to music. Nowhere else can you feel the Limburg feeling better than



at Borgitter Castle. Be sure to visit the artwork honouring this unique piece of history.

The work was created by a neighbouring school with both Flemish and Dutch students. Note: the entire site is privately owned.

Reconstruction electric wire

Right on the border between Belgium and the Netherlands, part of the triple electric wire from WWI was reconstructed. A location where many lost their lives during the war is now a place of peace and modesty. A covered picnic area was built for visitors. A number of information boards provide the necessary explanations about this monument.

GC De Stegel

GC De Stegel is the community centre of the municipality. With a very diverse range of exhibitions, theatre, music, etc., De Stegel has something for everyone. Fancy a relaxing evening out? Be sure to ask us about the possibilities during your stay or take a look at www.visitkinrooi.com.

NATURALLY Kinrooi

Kinrooi is a small municipality in the north of the province of Limburg. That in itself is not so unique, but with both the RivierPark Maasvallei and UNESCO Biosphere area KempenBroek, the municipality does have gateways to the most beautiful cross-border nature reserves in Limburg, including one that already became a Landscape Park in 2023. Ideal for a bike ride, a brisk walk or simply to get a breath of fresh air in nature. Are you coming along?

UNESCO Biosphere area KempenBroek

On the border of Belgian and Dutch Limburg with another strip of North Brabant lies UNESCO Biosphere area KempenBroek, a 25,000-hectare area that alternates wet with dry, open with closed and nature with culture. The Kinrooise share of this cross-border landscape is mainly found in Molenbeersel. That is where the nature areas Stramprooier-

broek, Grootbroek, Urlobroek, Zig and Goort are located.

Tijn the great oriole butterfly

Nature reserve De Goort is home to Tijn the great oriole butterfly.

This butterfly is the municipality's adopted species and occasionally turns up in the area. During the walk of about 2.5 km, children aged 3 to 6 can playfully learn about De Goort and Tijn's further habitat. This walk is completely free of charge. Parking is available on Doorslagstraat.

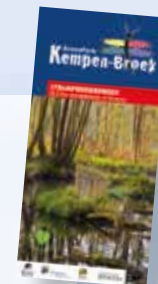

RivierPark Maasvallei

The RivierPark Maasvallei is an exceptional nature park with the whimsical Meuse as the blue thread running through the area. An impressive rain river, the Meuse forms the physical border between Belgium and the Netherlands for 40 km. Over the centuries, this stream modelled a multifaceted and fascinating landscape.

A tangle of old river arms, bank banks, stream channels, cut meanders, dykes and floodplains emerged. Adjoining these, some picturesque Meuse villages rise above nature. High and low water levels brought with them great diversity, a diversity that even today is still being tinkered with enormously with the sole aim of introducing as many new species as possible into the RivierPark Maasvallei.



FOR THE KIDS

'Rijntje and his friends'

In nature reserve Het Vijverbroek, an active experience trail of 2.3 km has been set up for the youngest nature lovers. The walk 'Rijntje and his friends' is an alternation of beautiful drawings, based on the natural inhabitants of the area, and fun activities to get to know nature in the RivierPark Maasvallei.

The walking route is suitable for toddlers from 2.5 years old. Especially to encourage a feel for nature, the route has not been made extra accessible for buggies.

Rose Route

From mid-June to mid-September, Geistingen is coloured by the most beautiful roses. No fewer than 2,000 roses decorate the Maria Park. A total of 6,000 roses will be on display in this beautiful Meuse village. Come and experience it with us during this period. The rose route is 6 km long and takes you past Luc Van Esser's ADR Rosarium Geistingen Landhoff, among others. During this period, the garden is free for individual visitors on Wednesdays.

The price of the walking map is €5.00. This includes a drink and ice cream on the way.

String of Meuse villages

This cross-border cycle route takes you through the northern part of the RivierPark Maasvallei.

You cycle around the Maasplassen and pass many cultural-historical sights such as the St. Martin 's church and the mottetower in Kessenich, the statue of the Van Eyck brothers in Maaseik, the Aldeneyck wine estate, the white town of Thorn and the Maasbracht lock complex. If the route is too long, you can shorten it via the bicycle ferry "President Willy Claes".

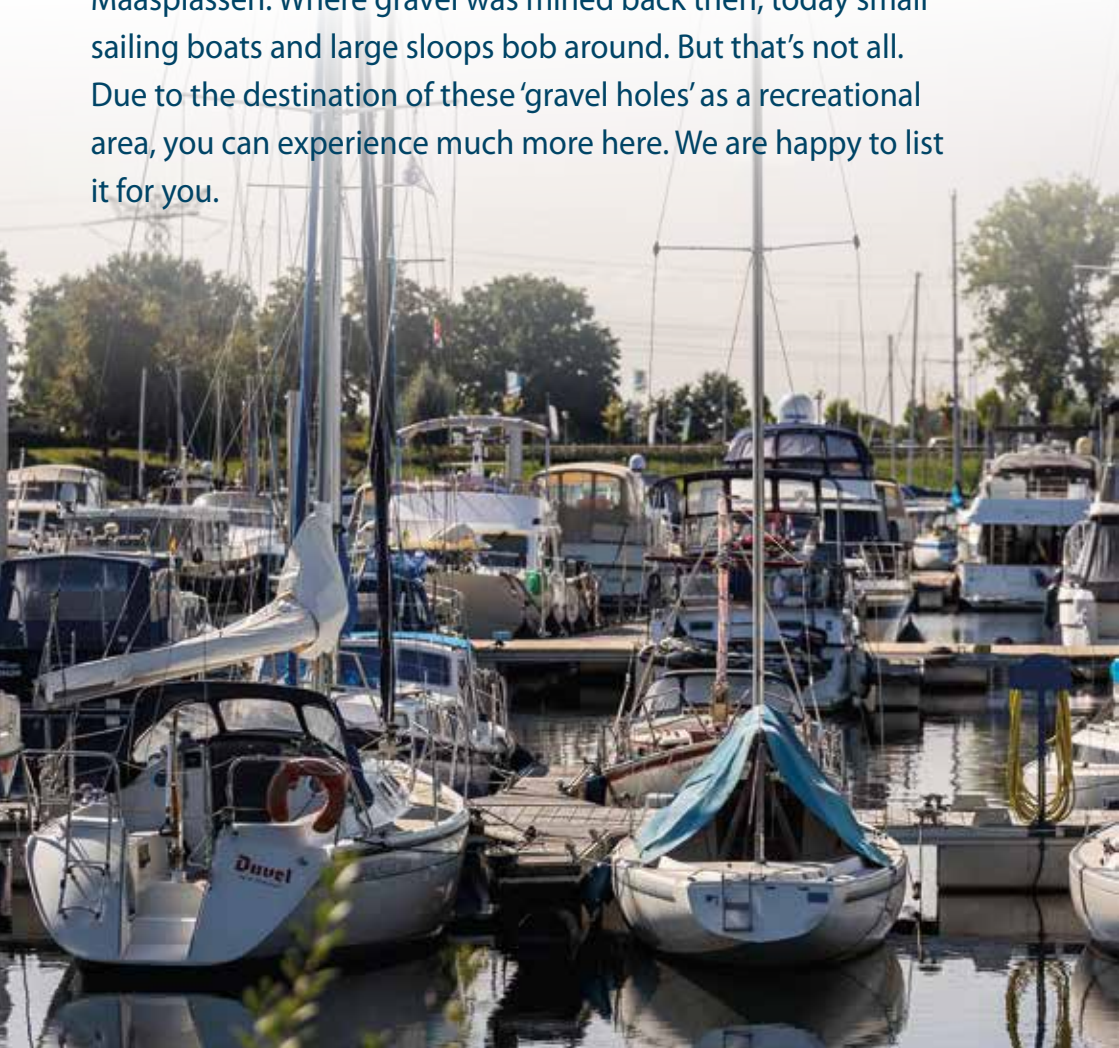

1 De Spaanjerd Marina

This marina is unique in Western Europe. With almost 1,000 berths, it is one of the largest inland marinas. The marina is managed by Marec DV. They are responsible for the rental of moorings and the maintenance of this site. Marina De Spaanjerd guarantees a top Mediterranean experience. 2 Day beach De Steenberg

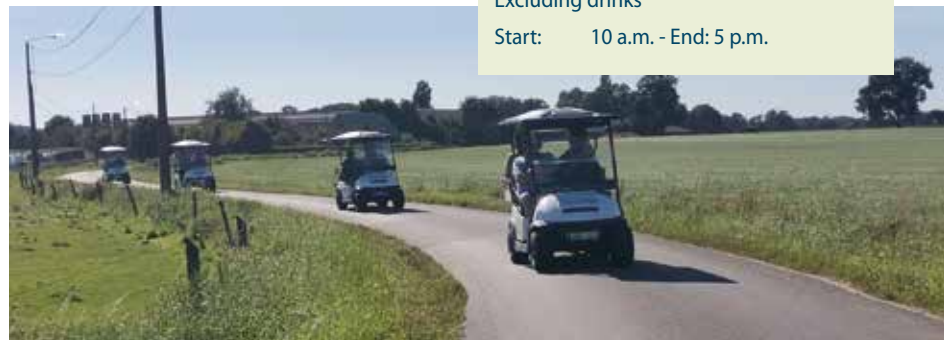
